Arbitration Agreement**

Whereas differences have arisen and are still subsisting between the said parties in respect to ..

Now it is hereby mutually agreed to refer the said differences to the Arbitration of
..... by whose award we agree to be bound.

The said Referee shall have power to call for receive and act upon any evidence or information oral or documentary and whether strictly admissible or not as he may think proper and in conducting the Arbitration and making the Award shall not be bound by the strict rules of procedure or evidence but save as aforesaid the Arbitration Act 1996 shall apply

Note: If either of the parties requires a Reasoned Award, such party shall request the same by written request to the Panel of Referees prior to notification by the Association that the Award is ready to be taken up. If no such request is made the Referee shall be entitled to give reasons for his decision but shall be under no duty to do so.
