**Form of Submission to Two Named Referees
Arbitration Agreement**

An agreement dated

Between

of the one part and of the other part.

Whereas differences have arisen and are still subsisting between the said parties in respect to ..

Now it is hereby mutually agreed to refer the said differences to the Arbitration of

..... and

by whose award we agree to be bound.

In the event of the said and

.....failing to agree it is hereby further mutually agreed that

.....*(or another Referee serving for the time being

on the Panel of the Association of Average Adjusters to be nominated by them) shall act as Umpire

by whose award we agree to be bound.

The said Referees and Umpire shall have power to call for receive and act upon any evidence or information oral or documentary and whether strictly admissible as evidence or not as they may think proper and in conducting the Arbitration and making the award shall not be bound by the strict rules of procedure or evidence but save as aforesaid the Arbitration Act 1996 shall apply.

Note: If the parties have nominated a particular Referee on the Panel to act as Umpire, the words in brackets should be deleted.

If either of the parties requires a Reasoned Award, such party shall request the same by written request to the Panel of Referees prior to notification by the Association that the Award is ready to be taken up. If no such request is made the Referee(s) shall be entitled to give reasons for his/their decision but shall be under no duty to do so.
